Duxford Preschool Cohort Summary

Who comes to our Preschool?

Duxford preschool is a term-time only setting providing care from 9:00 until 15:00 Monday to Friday.

Of the 42 children on roll up to 21 can attend per session with the majority of children attending part time.

Our current cohort is predominately white British with just 12% from other ethnic backgrounds. This 12% is reflective of county data being made up mostly of children from a European background with a very small percent of other cultures within the setting.

We currently have a higher percentage of boys in attendance, making up 59% of the entire cohort. 9.5% of the children on roll access EYPP (Early years pupil premium) funding. This funding is utilized to support the children in receipt across a variety of areas, which have been identified as in need, such as communication and language development and personal social and emotional development.

We are a fully inclusive setting and welcome families with children in need of extra help and support across the curriculum areas in order to meet their social, developmental and behavioural needs. We work with parents to access additional support (for example SEN Inclusion Funding (SENIF) and Disability Access Funding (DAF)) where it is felt this will benefit the child.
